## What is Bullying ?



- Bullying is repetitive. It happens more than once.
- There are different types of bullying such as verbal, cyber and physical.
- Bullies humiliate others and make them feel small.
- Bullies spread rumours about a particular person.

- If you get bullied don't be afraid to tell an adult.
