Dear Parents and Carers,

Update re Power Supply to the School

Thank you for your patience and understanding over the last few days, during our difficulties with the power supply to the school.

As we said in our update last Friday, there is a fault with the electricity meter at the point the power enters the school. This meter is the responsibility of Scottish Power and we are waiting for them to send an engineer out to assess and remedy the problem. With the help of Croydon Council, we are chasing them to do this as quickly as possible. Although we cannot say exactly when, we expect it will be sometime this week.

We have a temporary generator providing power for the school; this was installed by Croydon Council yesterday. The generator is fenced off but we will make sure that staff are positioned to stop children going near it during playtimes. We spoke to all the children about keeping safe and staying away from the generator, during our assemblies this morning. We would appreciate it if you could also talk to your children, to reinforce the importance of staying well away from the generator.

The Parent Meetings that had to be cancelled last Thursday have been rescheduled to next Thursday, 25 January. We will keep the same appointment times but if there are any difficulties with this please talk to your child's class teacher as soon as possible.

A small number of people did not receive the text updates we have been sending out. When we checked to see why, the phone numbers we have on record for them were "not recognised." Please remember to update your contact details with the office as soon as they change, so that we can be sure important information is getting to you.

As soon as we have more information about how long it is going to take to fix the problem we will let you know. In the meantime, the senior team and I will be on the gate in the mornings and after school, so do ask us any questions you may have.
