## Parent Governor Election

Please return your ballot form by **12:00 (midday) on Friday 23 March**. You can:

- Post it in the ballot box in the school foyer, or
- Post it to the school, in an envelope labelled Parent Governor Election, or
- Arrange for your child to bring it to the school, in an envelope, and post it in the ballot box.

Votes will be counted on Friday 23 March and the result will be announced as soon as possible.

The governing body is a vital part of the leadership of the school, so please do take them time to vote.
